If you are looking for a thorough understanding of the challenges of workplace safety and health and the knowledge to be able to mitigate and/or overcome them - this is your program.

Looking for an easy way to get a certificate? - this is not the program for you.

The curriculum includes core requirements and electives that allow participants to design the program best suited to their needs.

Though there are no educational requirements to enter the program, some classes require math and/or science knowledge and/or skills. Participants must also have professional level English language proficiency in reading comprehension, vocabulary, written expression and oral presentation.

Candidates must attend all sessions and pass written exams to receive credit towards SCERC Workplace Safety and Health Professional Certificate.

Workplace Safety & Health Professional Certificate

CORE Required Courses*

- Fundamentals of Workplace Safety - 3 days (includes OSHA 10-Hour card)
- Introduction to Industrial Hygiene - 3 days
- IIPP (Injury and Illness Prevention Program) - 1 day
- Incident Investigation - 1 day
- Workplace Violence Prevention - 1/2 day
- Indoor Air Quality - 2 days
- Sampling & Instrumentation - 2 days
- Confined Space Awareness - 1 day
- Fundamentals of Hazardous Materials - 1 day
- Ethics for Health and Safety Professionals - 4 hours
- Heat Illness Prevention - 1/2 day
- Bloodborne Pathogens - 1/2 day
- Ergonomics - 8 hours or 1 day
- Risk Assessment - 2 days
- Personal Protective Equipment - 1/2 day
- Chemical Hazards or Hazard Communication - 1 day

Electives* Candidates for Workplace Safety & Health Professional Certificate — Choose 24 hours of coursework from a list of accepted electives.

Who Should Attend

Safety managers, human resources managers, risk managers, industrial hygienists, hazardous materials managers, environmental managers, labor representatives, health and safety committee members, and anyone seeking to become a health and safety professional.

Accreditation

All courses should be eligible for the following accreditation: ABIH (Industrial Hygiene), BCSP (Safety Engineers), BRN (Registered Nurses [CA]). Some courses may be eligible for Human Resources and REHS (Environmental Health Specialist [CA] contact hours.
